11/09/2024 - Online Workshop/Discussion on Curriculum design and mismatch job supply demand, skills for changing society

Participants:

Short description:

The online discussion on curriculum design and job market alignment, hosted by Academia on September 11, 2024, highlighted key challenges and solutions in education systems. Participants emphasized the gap between theoretical curricula and labor market needs, with outdated content and insufficient practical training being major concerns. Practical placements varied significantly across institutions, with some offering only 40 hours, deemed too short for meaningful impact. The importance of soft skills development, flexibility in curricula, and greater teacher autonomy were recurring themes. Systemic barriers, such as rigid accreditation processes and lack of teacher industry experience, were noted as obstacles to adaptation. Solutions proposed included integrating real-world projects, expanding internships, reducing bureaucracy, and fostering flexibility to align with





local and global labor market demands. The session concluded with a call for systemic reforms to create a more adaptive and skills-focused education framework.
